

Minutes of the March 1, 2010 meeting of the SYS Board

The Minutes of the February meeting were approved.

Treasurer's Report (Mike R.)--The 1099 forms have been mailed. The IRS erroneously said we were late with last year's return but, in fact, we were on time. The program has approximately \$300,00 in the bank and uniforms and league fees have been paid.

Equipment Report (Natasha C.)—Natasha needs to know the total number of teams and she could use some help in assembling the equipment bags.

Scott said that Isaac has the uniforms for minis. The uniforms for the older teams are coming in to Roy slowly.

Field setup—on 3/27 we need volunteers to move the large goals from Glavin to Municipal. We will need a large flat-bed truck to do this. We also need to work on the walking path. Roy said that he would see if Lovey's could provide us with a truck to move the large goals. David Lizotte & Bob G will line the large parking lot. David will get bids on recapping the parking lot.

Scott said that there is a D3 Shrewsbury who wants to play for Grafton. The player supposedly has a lot of friends on the Grafton team. Since our U-10 teams are full, the board voted to ok this for this season only.

Player/Coach Development—(Ken W.)There will be 5 to 10 sessions for the minis run by Challenger. Every team will get a practice session. Ken needs the practice schedules for the minis. Ken said there will be a sessions for mini coaches at Teamworks on 3/22 from 6 to 8 PM (Roy P.) PlaySoccer will provide a coach who is dedicated to Shrewsbury Soccer 3 days a week. Each team will have one practice session with this coach and the session will be assigned ahead of time. Roy P. needs the practice schedules for the U10+ teams.

For try outs, we need to specify to Play Soccer what we want the format to be for the tryouts.

They agreed to cut \$5 an hour but they will charge us to do the paper work of entering the evaluations for each player.

Roy said that Challenger is still trying to figure out the format for the summer camps. He's waiting to hear from them.

AGCs reports--Jorge D. said all the U5 teams are set up but he still needs to fill out some forms. U6, U7, and U8 ABCs were not present.

GU10 Heston is all set.

BU10 Need to complete some rosters.

GU12 Chris W. is all set.

BU12 Not present but all set.

GU14+ Allen is still adding some players.

BU14+ Kevin R. still needs a few wavers for a few players.

Referee Report (Ann C.)—Ref meeting on 3/23 at the library. The U14+ will have ARs at games.

Mentors get \$25 an hour. Lisa M. suggested we continue with the mentors for the U10s. We will need an email vote to approve this addition to the budget. We will have U7 center refs in the spring. This serves as a kind of ref training. Ann will try to see that all U8 games have refs and then back-fill with U7s is she can. U-8s are doing throw-ins this season.

Town Field maintenance and town field status--Bob G will meet with Angela on March 15 and he will get all relevant info to coaches as soon as he know what the info is.

MAYS Report (Bob R.)—Bob needs pass cards and rosters by the end of the week. He said that MAYS is insisting that all coaches follow the letter fo the law when rescheduling rainouts.

The pre-season coaches' meetings will be at Sherwood M.S. from 7-9 PM.

The mini coaches will meet on 3/24.

The U10+ coaches will meet on 3/25.

The next meeting will be held on 4/5 at 7 PM downstairs at JJ's.
